



QLD MURRAY DARLING BASIN LANDCARE SCHOLARSHIPS

FOR STUDENTS TO UNDERTAKE INDUSTRIAL PLACEMENT

The scholarship was established in 2002 and maintained by an annual gift of \$3000 from the QMDC to encourage study and work in environmental, Landcare and catchment management within the Queensland Murray Darling Basin.

Two scholarships of \$3000 each, are awarded annually

Candidates must be enrolled full-time in the third year of the Bachelor of Environmental Management - Natural Systems & Wildlife Management, Rural Technology, or Rural Systems Management, or in the Bachelor of Agricultural Science – Rural Management.

The scholarships are awarded to applicants showing the greatest merit, as demonstrated by:

1. Academic achievement during the first two years of the Bachelor of Environmental Management - Natural Systems & Wildlife Management, Rural Technology, or Rural Systems Management, or in the Bachelor of Agricultural Science – Rural Management.
2. Proposed industrial placement project and its relevance to the Queensland Murray Darling Basin
3. Evidence of the candidate's likely future success in natural resources management including aptitude for community based natural resource management and track record of volunteering
4. Personal qualities, including leadership potential
